Dear Pastors, Friends, and Faithful Supporters,

Greetings from the beautiful, albeit currently chilly, Welsh countryside! We hope this letter finds you resting in the abundant grace of our Lord. As we look back on the start of 2026, our hearts are full of gratitude for your continued partnership in this ministry.

#### A Winter Wonderland

January certainly made its entrance with a flourish! We were greeted by a solid week of snow, leaving us with about 8 inches of beautiful white accumulation. While it made travel a bit of a "slow-motion" adventure, it was an absolute joy to watch the neighborhood children sledding down the hills in the sheep pasture right behind our house. There is something about a fresh blanket of snow that reminds us of the cleansing power of Christ's love.

#### Soup, Singing, and the Savior

This month, we hosted our first major community event of the year: our annual Soup and Singing night. We invited a local choir to provide music, and we spent days preparing various soups and desserts for the town.

After a last-minute cancellation from our supporting group, which was scheduled to sing and share the gospel message between the choir's two sets, Dana graciously stepped in to fill that role. She was able to sing a few hymns and weave the gospel message between them in a way that people actually listened. We were blessed to have the opportunity to share God's love and the story of salvation with around 75 people that evening, most of whom are not associated with any church or chapel. The community response was overwhelming, with many folks asking us to "do it again soon!" Please pray that the seeds of the Gospel planted that night will take deep root.

#### Milestones and Ministry Matters

January 19th marked our four-year anniversary here in Wales! It is hard to believe how quickly the time has flown, and we are so humbled that God has allowed us to serve here.

Looking ahead, we do have a significant prayer request. The UK government is currently debating changes to visa and residency rules, with a vote expected in mid-February. This leaves us in a period of uncertainty regarding whether we will apply for permanent residency or renew our visas at the end of this year. Regardless of the outcome, the process will be quite costly, ranging anywhere from \$10,000 to \$25,000. If you feel led to help with these upcoming "Visa Fees," you may send contributions to our mission board marked accordingly.
