Dear praying friends and faithful supporters,

Cathy and I have had a blessed fall and have been greatly encouraged by the fruit we've seen over the past few months.

September began with the School of Evangelism held outside of Chattanooga. We had approximately 20 students join us for a week of study, mutual encouragement, and hands-on evangelism on the streets. My group was able to spend time at the university, and I was amazed at the openness and response to the gospel. We have received reports from all over the country of students putting into practice what they learned and engaging in evangelism in even greater ways within their home churches. We already have three more School of Evangelism classes scheduled for next year.

God truly has been raising up laborers this year! As Scripture says, "Pray ye therefore the Lord of the harvest, that He will send forth laborers into His harvest" (Matthew 9). We are seeing this prayer answered in many ways. The Who Will Go camps, conferences, and mission trips; the Macedonia "Reach the World" conferences; and the Ignite Youth Missions Conferences have kept Cathy and me very busy. Along with these, preaching missions conferences and presenting the need for missions from Sunday to Sunday has led to a noticeable increase in interest. At this time, Cathy and I are ministering to several new prospective missionary families, not to mention the many single young people whom God is stirring toward missions.

Over the last 10 weeks, I have only been able to spend a few days at home here and there, but December should allow us a window to catch up on work at home and minister in several churches nearby. We are also trying to finish some work on a rental property so that we can finally get it sold. Please pray that we can complete this project and see the property move soon, as it has become a burden while we are on the road so much.

January will take us back on the road full-time, and we are already almost fully booked through January and February. In the spring, we will return to Europe for a trip to Macedonia, and summer will keep us busy as we lead a team of young missionaries on an evangelistic trip through Europe.

For the past four years, Benjamin and Amanda have served alongside us as we have preached the gospel, ministered to missionary families, and trained new laborers. In a few weeks, however, Ben will be moving to serve with a church in southern Illinois. Please pray for him as he takes on this new responsibility and ministry opportunity to the youth at Trinity Baptist Church in Murphysboro, Illinois. He will be greatly missed, but we are praying that God's hand will be upon him and that the Lord will use him mightily as he serves our Savior.

Thank you for your friendship, your prayers, and your faithful support. We are grateful to share the fruit of this ministry with you, our dear friends.
