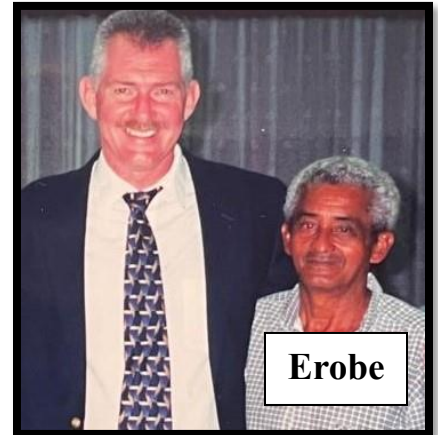


PRAYER LETTER – January 2026

I flew to Recife and then we traveled for five hours, by car, to arrive at this small town located in the highlands of the state of Pernambuco. On the way we saw landscapes of green hills covered in sugarcane stalks and we traveled through miles of banana plantations. I saw things that I had only heard about before.
