January and February have been months of continued adjustment and growing familiarity with the area. The winter season here in New Hampshire has certainly been colder and snowier than what I was used to in North Carolina, but the Lord has helped me settle in and grow more comfortable with life and ministry here.

It has been a great joy to be able to work with a local pastor here in New Hampshire! The church has been amazing to be able to get involved with. Once I arrived here in New Hampshire, we started to get to work. I have had the privilege to be able to lead singing and to preach, and the pastor has me currently running a Bible study for some students here at Keene State College who go to the church.

Looking ahead, the pastor has also given me the opportunity, beginning in May, to preach in the Sunday afternoon services and to preach through the book of Titus. Please also keep the summer months in prayer. In June, July, and August, we are planning to hold a Vacation Bible School in the park on a Saturday each month. Please pray as we begin preparing and doing outreach for these events that the Lord will give wisdom and that we will have a good attendance at each of these Saturdays.

With the church plant planned for Peterborough, please also continue to pray for that community. Through the opportunities I have been given, I have been able to spend time working on some things at the Peterborough library where, Lord willing, the church will eventually be started. This has allowed me to spend time in the community and make connections. I have also been able to reserve a room at the library for the college Bible study to go ahead and get my name in the system.

I am very thankful for how the Lord continues to guide and provide as this ministry moves forward. Your faithful prayers and support make it possible for me to be here serving in New England, and I am grateful for your partnership in the gospel.
