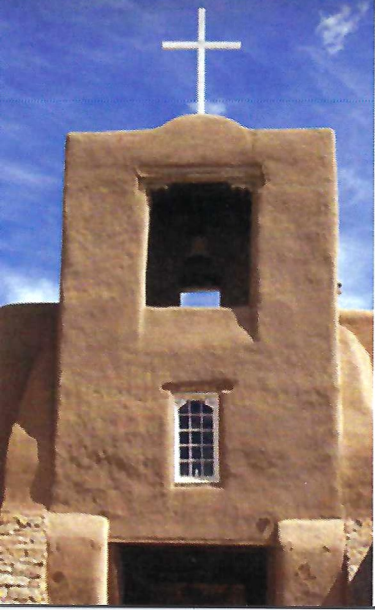

Rogers Update February 2026

Well, it has been a few months since we wrote. A lot has happened in our ministry. We thank all those who have prayed for us and supported us financially. Your faithfulness to the Lord and the support of world missions is being used so that fruit may abound to your account.

Since coming to you last, we brought another man on board with His Harvest Ministries. Brother Marco Sanchez and his family are a great asset and blessing to this wonderful work. They are currently working in the first church plant that they took over from Brother Valenzuela. Brother Valenzuela is working now in the city, planting a church in Nuevo Casas Grandes. Both of these churches are averaging in the 30s in attendance. At Brother Marcos' church, we are currently building the church building. This church is on track to be constituted in the next year and a half to 2 years. Brother Charlie Powell has been able to purchase the building in Monteverde in which he is currently meeting in his second mission. His mission in Janos is doing quite well although it seems as if Monteverde is growing quite faster. We have found that each church and town has its own personality and speed. Both of his mission churches have their own buildings that have been purchased and are in the process of completion. The mission in Samloapon, which is led by Brother Eduardo Orozco, has the building started. This building has the walls up, and they are currently waiting on the welder to weld the trusses. This building is much needed since they have been meeting in a house in a little living room for quite some time. His other mission that is meeting in Santa Isabel is also meeting in a house, and God is blessing there. Brother Pacheco's mission in the capital of Chihuahua state is doing well and running about 30 in attendance. Brother Monta Rubio is doing well in Talatenango, Zacatecas, where they are meeting in a rented building but are currently looking for a piece of property that we can purchase and start the building process of their own facility. The church in Las Vegas, NM has been constituted as of our last letter, and they are currently hitting in the thirties in attendance frequently. Brother Wayne Matheson is doing a wonderful job at this church. The mission in Antonito, Colorado that I am operating is doing well with an average attendance of close to 20 locals on a regular basis. We are currently having a family of 10 travel 2 hours from Antonito every Sunday to attend services at Harvest Baptist Church here in Santa Fe.

The warehouse property is growing, and we have distributed several thousand Bibles and around a million tracts over the past year to churches that need them. Several church planting kits have been distributed to our churches which outfit them with all the equipment they need to function as a church. There has been a single wide trailer donated to this property that we are currently remodeling. This will be used as a mission house on this property. Also, the corner lot beside it has been agreed upon to purchase for \$11,000

which will expand what we're doing as well as give us potential room for a future church plant in Columbus, New Mexico once we get the right man for the job.

Over the course of Christmas time, the different events that all the daughter churches and missions of Harvest Baptist Church, as well as the mother church itself, averaged approximately 600 in attendance. This was a result of all the Christmas events, with many being saved in the process.

Right now, we are finishing up the Bible studies being held at our state capitol every Thursday since the legislators are in session. We have had several staff as well as at least one legislator attend during these Bible studies. Continue to pray as we are Salt and Light in our state capitol.

There are several building projects going on at Harvest Baptist Church to remodel the church facilities. Over the last year, we have been able to remodel the dining hall, add another missions apartment and remodel two bathrooms completely. We have also been able to completely remodel a couple of the hallways. We have been able to put a new roof on the facilities, which was much needed, as well as a furnace downstairs to heat a portion of the building that has not been heated in over a decade and a half. Right now, we are working on the two upstairs bathrooms. The next project will be the nursery and beginner corridor. We have been able to start two more Sunday School classes here at Harvest over the last couple of months. We currently have a total of nine Sunday School classes.

We have seen some deaf people get saved and are now interpreting our messages over the screen for them to read while in the congregation. Pray for this ministry to continue to expand. We restarted our van ministry this summer; it is currently being led by my two oldest sons as well as a couple of other gentlemen in the church that assist.

Right now, our oldest son Clint, who is 15, will be flying out to Honduras to begin a internship that will last for 6 weeks. He is going to be spending this time in the remote La Moskitia region with the indigenous people that live there. Missionary Gene Trask has been serving here for many years, and we pray that Clint will be a help and that God would work in his heart also.

We are looking forward to potentially adding two more missions this year. Continue to pray for God to work this out. We will also be starting a circuit ministry in which several more towns a month will become preaching points between the states of Sonora and Chihuahua. Continue to pray as Harvest Baptist Church and His Harvest Ministries (which is our church planting arm and ministry of Harvest Baptist Church) both continue to grow and expand. Do continue to pray for the Rogers family as the ministry grows and our family continues to serve the Lord for his glory!
