As many of you know, we have been searching for a home in which to live. We were given a time frame to be out of the current house on February 1, and we were not sure what we would do. As we have mentioned previously, it is very difficult to find housing in the Netherlands due to a great housing shortage. Praise the Lord, He has provided a house for us to call home for 1 year. At the end of the year, we will be required to move again. Even so, we are thankful to the Lord for hearing and answering our prayers.

Please pray for us as we continue to learn the Dutch language. We underestimated how difficult it would be to learn this language. I am enrolled and beginning a very intensive course to learn Dutch. Please pray that the Lord will help me as I continue working towards fluency in Dutch. My family and I are working each day to learn more in order to be able to move towards planting a church in this area.

The Lord has been dealing with me recently about beginning Gospel meetings in a few different areas. This would allow us to reach people in different areas and present the Gospel. There are a few obstacles to this however. First of all, we need a place to meet in each city. The Lord has placed 3 different cities on my heart to begin these meetings. We need an affordable place in each of these cities to meet. Also, we need help from native Dutch speakers. We have found some software that would allow us to use translation for those who cannot understand English fully. We need a native speaker in each area to help us ensure proper translation. We do not want confusion if the translation is not correct. Please pray with us that the Lord will meet these needs in His time and according to His will. We are confident that the Lord will not lead us in an area and not provide what is needed to accomplish the mission.

We made a trip back to America in the last few weeks for a very sad reason. My 94 year old grandmother passed away. I had the privilege to preach at her funeral. The Gospel was presented many times throughout the service. Please pray for family members who were at the funeral but do not know the Lord. We trust that the Lord will draw all men to Him as He promised in His Word.
