Update letter for Jan-Mar 2026

Over the past three months, the Lord has greatly blessed our deputation travels. We have had the privilege of being in ten different states, presenting our burden for the mission field, and connecting with many wonderful churches. We are thankful to report that the Lord has allowed us to gain 15 new supporting churches during this time, pushing us past 33% of our goal. We are continually humbled by God's provision and the generosity of His people.

While visiting several churches in Wichita, KS, we learned that Bethel Baptist Church was in the process of remodeling their auditorium. Though they had a strong group of volunteers helping with the work, they were in need of a new pulpit and Lord's Supper table. They had been quoted a cost of \$10,000-\$12,000 to have them custom built. By God's grace, I was able to build both, the pulpit and the Lord's Supper table, for only \$750 in materials. It was a joy to be a blessing to the church in this way and help them save a significant amount of money in the process.

We also had the opportunity to go soul-winning and canvassing with First Baptist Church in Wildwood, MO. While we were out, I was able to have a meaningful conversation with a man named Robert, who comes from a Catholic background. He shared that he does not believe what he has been taught by the Catholic church his whole life and expressed interest in visiting a Baptist church for the first time. Please pray for Robert and his family as they consider this important step in search of the truth.

While attending a Missions Conference at Faith Baptist Church in Oak Creek, WI, I met a man named Sattesh who was working at our hotel. He is originally from India and fled to America to escape persecution after disposing of Hindu idols. Tragically, his brother-in-law was killed, and Sattesh himself was in danger before escaping with his wife. I was able to invite him to attend a service during the missions conference, and he joined us. Please pray for Sattesh and his wife as they adjust to life in America and seek a Bible-believing church.

A couple of weeks ago, we were able to pass out Bibles with Pastor Kiefer and Heartland Baptist Church in Perryville, MO. I was able to give a Bible to a young man named Daniel. He said that he had been praying for God to give him a Bible. His son, Liam, has been diagnosed with terminal cancer. I told him that we would be praying for him. Please join me in praying for God's will to be done in his life. Daniel is seeking hope. I pray that he can find that hope in Jesus Christ. Thank you for your continued prayers and support. We are grateful to partner with you in reaching souls for Christ.
