March-April 2026

We trust this letter finds you well. We truly love the ministry God has called us to, and your faithful prayers and support make this work possible. We are deeply grateful for your partnership in everything the Lord is doing.

In our last letter, we mentioned that we would be assisting the Helms family in Cordova, AK, with their first Vacation Bible School. It was a great success with 23 children attending, the majority of whom were from the local community. It was such an honor to be a part of this. Brother Elijah and his family are doing a wonderful job in the town God has called them to; it is truly a beautiful family effort. While there, I finished teaching on evangelistic tools, and we were blessed to hold a Bible study with 3 Coast Guard men and one of their wives. The study covered how to write a Gospel tract and addressed various other biblical topics. It was encouraging to see how eager they were to learn and grow in God's word. We are thankful for our 6 weeks in Cordova and look forward to hopefully returning in the future.

We left Cordova by ferry on March 12th and have since been traveling through Alaska visiting churches and missionaries. I have had several opportunities to fill in for pastors, preach, and present our ministry. This trip has been an eye opener for our family regarding the great need for faithful laborers here. While Alaska is beautiful, it is in desperate need of the Gospel. We pray our ministry can encourage the dear people already laboring here to remain faithful to the Alaskan people. That is the core goal of Second-Man Ministry: to share the Gospel of Jesus Christ around the world and to encourage God's servants to stay faithful and "keep on keeping on" wherever He has placed them.

Looking ahead, we will be assisting with a missions training camp in Alabama called "Who Will Go?" which focuses on practical and spiritual training for those interested in the mission field. This will be our fourth year helping with this tremendous camp.

Immediately following the camp in June, we will take our third annual trip to Van Buren, Maine. We plan to spend four weeks laboring alongside the Stephen York family at Gateway Baptist Church where he and his family have been faithfully serving for 7 years. It will be a busy trip filled with various projects and events. Deanna will be speaking at a ladies' meeting held at the church, and we will also be helping with their second Vacation Bible School. Our goal is to assist with the costs of these two church events as well as several building projects. We will be replacing the church's siding and the handicap ramp. The estimated cost for equipment rentals and supplies for these two projects alone is approximately \$10,000. Including the two church events and food for the month, our total fundraising goal is \$13,500. Praise the Lord \$800 came in for this trip before we even made it public! God is Faithful, and we know HE will provide like He always does! The remaining needed cost is \$12,700.

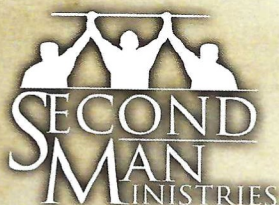
