We certainly hope that this letter finds you well by the grace of the good Lord. 2 Thessalonians 1:3 says, "We are bound to thank God always for you, brethren, as it is meet..." for the prayers of the saints are greatly appreciated and most certainly coveted, especially in the times in which we live.

Our family is doing good by the grace of God. Josiah, our eldest son, who has level 1 autism, is now in 1st grade in a private school and is no longer attending full-time therapy at a learning center. He is performing well academically. However, he is still getting use to functioning in a normal school environment. Jonathan is still in day care/pre-school and will be joining his brother at school in September. Please continue to pray for them that they will come to know Jesus the Christ as their Lord and Savior at a young and tender age and that Josiah will continue to get all the help he needs for his development.

Concerning the ministry, a number of things have transpired over the past few months, and the ministry, as we know, is not without its challenges. But amidst all those challenges, God has been more than faithful. We have been to a number of schools, both primary schools (ages 5–11) and secondary schools (ages 11–16), distributing Bibles and having devotion with the students and teachers. We also distributed Bibles to a number of police stations. Through The Every Village Project, we have preached in a number of villages: Top and Bottom Stubbs, Langley Park, and Camden Park. We also visited Spring Village, where we distributed Bibles and gospel tracts to the community. Missionary David Ballinger and I are still having Bible study every Monday night at the waterfront in Layou. We have been looking for a permanent place to have service, but we have been unfortunate so far. Please pray that we find a place, if it be the Lord's will.

Please continue to pray for lost souls in St. Vincent and the Grenadines. Our plan is to go to Mesopotamia later in the year to do a church plant there if the good Lord wills it; so pray for us as we seek the mind of God. Pray that the Lord will provide for our family as we look to return to the US to continue deputation in late June to August. Pray for The Every Village Project that the good Lord will continue to bless us, guide us, and provide for us as we move from village to village, preaching the gospel.

Know that we appreciate you and are praying that the Lord will continue to bless you as well.
