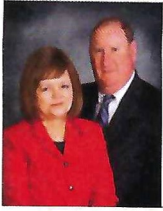

Dear Pastor and Praying Friends:

We have a busy spring and summer planned starting on Easter Sunday. Easter we have a fellowship after the morning service. Usually, this is well attended. The 4th of July will be a very busy time. We will enter a float in the local parade on the 4th. Also, we will set up a tent at the church and give away KJV Bibles and New Testaments in the Ojibwa language, which is the language the Chippewa speak. We will also be able to deal with any that need counseling or need to be saved. There will be free hot dogs and drinks. On the 5th, we will have a patriotic service in the morning, and VBS will start that Sunday night and go through Tuesday night. The week before the 4th we will be building the float and getting candy and literature ready to hand out during the parade. This is just some of the things we will be doing.

I am also excited to report that the church is showing signs of growth. We have a long way to go, but we are making progress. In the past couple of months we have had 4 new people start coming to church. Tonight, we had three new teenagers come. As we were entering church tonight, these three teens were walking past the church, and my wife greeted them and invited them to come to church tonight. They looked at each other and wanted to know what time. She told them 6:00pm, and they said they would come. They did. I know this isn't revival breaking out, but it is a sign that the Lord is still working.

Our song leader had shoulder surgery a few weeks ago, and his left arm is immobile for 3 months. Then physical therapy for 6 more months. We don't have a piano player at the moment, but he plays the guitar so he has been playing and leading singing. Now he can't play for awhile so I am playing guitar while he leads singing. It worked out pretty good this morning.

Along with my back and nerve issues, I have arthritis in my hips. About 3 months I was in severe pain with this. I went to the clinic, and they gave me a steroid shot in my left hip, and the pain went away. It is coming back now so I will go in on the 30th of March to get another one in both hips. Pray that this works as well as the first one. I will have an EMG last of April which will determine if I qualify for an electronic nerve stimulator that hopefully will help the pain and buckling of my right leg. We will see.

My wife is doing well. We are looking forward to our oldest granddaughter possibly moving in with us. She has a prospect for a job close by, and if she gets it, she will live with us and work. She will also be a great asset to the church. When my son and his family lived here a few years ago, Ada attracted many teens to the church. She loves the Lord and has a kind heart. We have really missed all the family since they have moved to Oklahoma. If I can only keep her away from my cowboy hats. I have to say though she looks a whole lot better wearing it than I do.

With the snowmelt, our place flooded a few weeks ago. We are now trying to dry it out to replace all the flooring. Satan has definitely tried to discourage us, but we will continue to serve the Lord and build a church amongst the Chippewa Indians. God bless you all.
