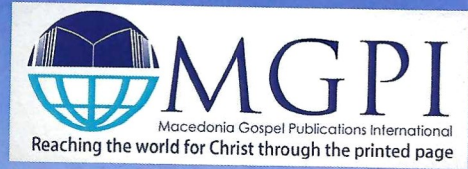
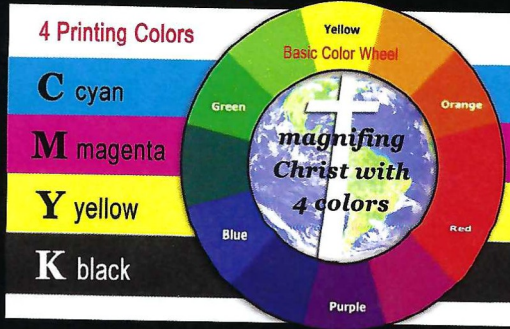

As an "O man" I must rest in God's strength. I'm powerless to get myself to heaven and my works fall short of His glory. To live for Him and do His will is my daily calling.

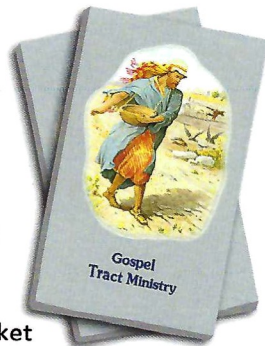
Print Shop Updates:

This first quarter of 2026 has been busy as we are focused on printing quality Gospel tracts. We have created several new tract designs in English and Spanish since these languages are the most requested. Other language tracts are made as needed. These are shipped all over the USA and around the world.

Other projects like post cards, brochures, letterheads, tith envelopes and special tracts have also been printed and shipped. We have printed several stapled booklet orders so far this year too. Some of our old printing equipment has been removed to increase available work space. Now we can add more tables and chairs for the volunteer workers.

Carry Pack Project:

People who make it a habit to carry Gospel tracts in their pocket or purse often describe a need for preventing curled, damaged tracts. Some sort of carrying pack is needed. Well, a "Tract Carry Pack" is just about ready. This little folder will hold and protect about ten tracts from the dreaded pocket curl. Final details are being addressed before production starts. They will measure 5.75" x 3.375".

Sylvia and I are excited to meet him sometime soon.

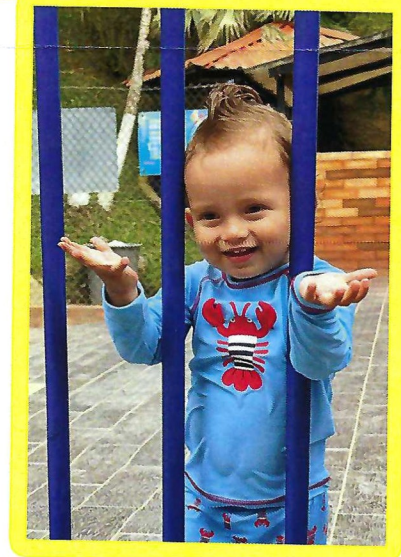
New Prayer Request:
