Dear Pastors, Friends, and Faithful Supporters,

As we continue our ministry here in Wales, we are reminded that much of the Christian life is found in the "patient continuance" of the work. While the world often looks for big headlines, we are finding God's grace in the quiet, steady moments of labor.

### A Blessed Discovery

The greatest highlight of this past month occurred during a Wednesday evening Bible study. Our coworkers were away for a funeral, so we held a combined class for the men and women. Dana and I decided to use "Resurrection Eggs" to lead an interactive journey through the crucifixion and resurrection of our Lord.

This is not a common tool here in the UK, and for most of our group, it was their first time seeing the story told this way. It was a joy to see their faces as they passed the eggs around and glanced inside. Some were perplexed by the symbols within, while others had that wonderful "gleam in their eye" as they realized the biblical connection. We had a fantastic time of discussion, and the fellowship was so sweet that many stayed long after the study just to "chit-chat" and share what they had learned. It was a refreshing reminder that the Word of God is always new and powerful.

### Laboring in the Routine

The rest of April has been filled with the routine, relational work that is so vital in this field. I have been keeping busy with my preaching opportunities, regular volunteer work at the local luncheon club, and attending the bowls club. These activities provide the consistent presence needed to build trust and lasting relationships within our community.

While I am out in the community, Dana has been working incredibly hard behind the scenes. She is currently deep in the planning and organization for our upcoming Holiday Bible Club at the end of May. This is a significant undertaking, and her work is essential to making this outreach a success. Please pray for her as she prepares the materials and for the children who will attend and hear the Gospel, many for the first time.

### Resting in His Timing

Regarding our visa situation, we are continuing to wait on the Lord's timing. We were originally told to expect a decision by March or April. We have now been informed that the government is still finalizing the details, and it is likely we won't have a final update until the autumn. While these delays are trying, we know that nothing catches our God by surprise. Whatever the decision, we will have a minimum of \$15,000 in fees by the end of the year, so we appreciate all the donations that have been and will be given for this upcoming need.

Thank you for being our "yokefellows" in this ministry. Your prayers and support sustain us in this difficult, but beautiful, land.
