Dear Friends, Family, and Faithful Partners,

We hope you are doing well. We want to share an **IMPORTANT UPDATE** regarding the handling of our ministry support.

First, we thank the Lord for the privilege of serving as **missionaries since 2011**, and on the field in **Colombia since 2013**. Over these years, God has allowed us to see the Gospel advance in ways that only He could accomplish. By his grace, we have seen four local churches established, a Bible Institute training national leaders, a recording studio producing daily Gospel content seen by millions, and a feeding and education center serving 74 children each day.

We are deeply grateful for the past **15 years of partnership with Macedonia World Baptist Missions**. Their support and friendship have been a tremendous blessing to our family and ministry.

After much prayer and counsel, and with the encouragement of our sending church, **we will be transitioning the handling of our support to Lighthouse Baptist Church**. This is not a change in doctrine or ministry philosophy, but a step that reflects our strong belief in the role of the local church in missions.

Macedonia will continue processing our support **through the end of June**, after which they will return all checks. As of this month, please send all support to:

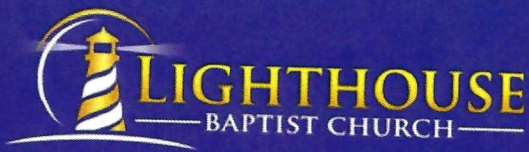

He studied in our Bible college and trained in our ministry. I spent many hours personally mentoring him, and it has been my joy to see him become so successful. Your prayers and support have been a big part of their success.

Aaron is an exceptional missionary. He has started multiple churches, established an outreach/feeding center for youth, trained many men for ministry in their institute, and developed a recording studio that produces gospel programs and has seen millions of views. Furthermore, Aaron is an exceptional husband and father.

In recent years, we have encouraged the missionaries sent from our church to allow us to handle their finances and provide them with the support and oversight that would otherwise be done by a mission board. I have been very active in the Vance's ministry. I have traveled to Bucaramanga multiple times. My wife and I have visited to support them, and we have also hosted groups from our church to visit and assist in their ministry. We have a financial staff who can receive, process, and issue receipts for the support received for our missionaries. We currently take care of this for three of our missionaries.

I have encouraged the Vances to resign from Macedonia World Baptist Missions and to allow Lighthouse Baptist Church to do the same for him, as we are doing for several other missionaries from our church. We currently support many missionaries assisted by MWBM, and we are grateful for all they have done for the Vances and continue to do for all the missionary families who are part of their organization. We will continue our support of MWBM and their missionaries.

Let me say that when our missionaries are cared for directly by our church, it has been an encouragement to both the missionaries and our church. Our relationship with them has grown so much, and we have become much closer. I believe the same will happen with the Vances.
